WHAT TO WEAR

WHAT WILL MY INDIVIDUAL AUDITION CONSIST OF?

- Snare/Tenor – Legatos, Roll Speed, Triplet Diddle, a 60 Sec. PREPARED Solo, and a sightreading etude
- Bass – Split parts to Legatos, Roll Speed, and Triplet Diddle, and sightreading etude
- Cymbals – You will receive a short sample of music (day of) and be asked to learn/perform it in groups of 4 or more (depending on turnout).

IF YOU CANNOT ATTEND BOTH AUDITIONS

It is STRONGLY recommended that everyone attends both auditions, however if you live a long distance from Orlando or have an unavoidable conflict, and can only attend one please reach out for our video audition requirements. To be considered you MUST attend one of the two auditions.

STATE COLLEGE STUDENTS (VALENCIA, SEMINOLE AND DAYTONA STATE COLLEGE)

You must have filled out the intent to march form as well as completed the application for admission to UCF as a non-degree seeking student before May 1, 2020. Failure to do so will automatically eliminate you from auditioning.
